

## Want to be part of a Riding Club team?

**South Brent Riding Club aims to give everyone a chance to compete in Dressage, Show Jumping and Horse Trials.**

Every member who wishes to be in a team must make sure that their horse's flu vaccinations are up to date! It will be checked and you will be eliminated if there are any discrepancies. We can do this for you!

There are -

Winter Qualifiers; in Dressage and Show Jumping.

Summer Qualifiers; in all 3 disciplines.

We have to submit preliminary entries to the BRC head office at least 21 days before!

£25 for a team and £7.50 for individuals (Dressage and SJ)

£45.50 for HT teams and £20 HT individual.

This money is non-refundable. However SBRC will pay this if you compete.

There are also entry fees payable to the area organiser.

You can compete as an individual or as part of a team.

Teams are of 4 or occasionally of 3, the best 3 scores to count.

### ***Dressage***

**Senior Winter Competition**- this is for teams only.

Teams of 4, with 3 scores to count.

2 riders ride a Prelim Test and 2 a Novice Test.

**Senior Open Dressage** (Summer competition)

For teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count, and for individuals (all team members are automatically in the individual competition). All riders will ride a different test; there are 3 different Novice Tests and 1 Elementary Test.

**Senior Novice Dressage** (Summer Competition)

For teams of 4 riders, with 3 scores to count. All riders will ride the same Prelim Test.

Also held at the summer competition are Dressage to Music for individuals or Pairs only.

The Winter Qualifiers are held usually in January or early February. So we need to know who is interested before Christmas! Next years tests will be Prelim 18 (2002) and Novice 24 (2010)

### ***Show Jumping***

Riders jump 2 rounds. The second round is timed.

**Novice Indoor SJ**- usually held in early February

For teams of 4 riders, with best 3 scores to count. There is no individual competition.

First Round max height 80cm Second Round 85cm.

**Novice, Intermediate and Open Outdoor SJ**- held in June/July

For teams of 4 riders, with best 3 scores to count, and individuals.

Novice course heights as above

Intermediate- 1<sup>st</sup> round 95cm, 2<sup>nd</sup> round 1m.

Open- 1<sup>st</sup> round 1.10m, 2<sup>nd</sup> round 1.15m.

### ***Horse Trials***

Only one area qualifier is held in the summer.

No horse or pony may have been ridden over any fences used in the Area Qualifier during the 2 weeks prior to the qualifier.

**Senior Novice HT**- for teams of 4 riders, with best 3 scores to count, and individuals.

Jumping heights 90cm

**Senior Intermediate HT**- as above

Jumping heights 1m

**Senior Open HT**- as novice

Jumping heights 1.10m

We want everyone who is keen to get a chance, but we won't chase you! The SBRC Team Organisers are Andrea Newton and Shona Morton.
